<b>1. Welcome and agenda approval</b>	<i>G. Meijer welcomed the participants.  The group reviewed the actions coming from the previous meetings. The agenda was approved.</i>

<b>2. Food 2030 conference</b>	<i>LT members who attended the High-Level event on Food 2030 conference held by the Commission shared their take away messages from the conference. They found remarkable the consensus about the need for action to ensure Food and Nutrition Security and the solutions that will allow us to tackle the current challenges. They also welcome the inclusion of nutrition when talking about food security and in the Bioeconomy strategy.  The LT also acknowledged that the consumer focus given to the draft SRIA aligns nicely with the views of the speakers who participated in the conference.</i>

Updates on cross-ETP meetings (TP Organics, ETP Plants for the Future, WssTP, Animal Task Force)</b></p>	<p><i>The Secretariat briefed the LT about the collaborations established with other ETPs.</i></p> <p><i>In the case of TP Organics, a joint paper was developed describing common areas of interest for both TP Organics and ETP Food for Life. This paper was distributed at the Food 2030 conference, and it is also available at the ETP website.</i></p> <p><i>Another paper is being developed jointly by the experts of the ETPs Food for Life and Plants for the Future.</i></p> <p><i>The Secretariat has also discussed possible ways of collaboration with the WssTP and the Animal Task Force.</i></p>
<p><b>4. Next steps: Implementation Action Plan</b></p>	<p><i>The SRIA sets the strategy of the ETP. The next step will be defining in the Implementation Action Plan (IAP) the actions that need to be taken to execute the strategy and with which resources. The group agreed to start developing an IPA document once the final SRIA is published.</i></p>
<p><b>5. Feedback received on the draft Strategic Research and Innovation Agenda</b></p>	<p><i>The LT and the chairs/co-chairs of the Scientific Working Groups reviewed the input received during the public consultation on the draft SRIA. The draft SRIA will be revised accordingly.</i></p>
